Identification of type 2 diabetes & pre-diabetes in the oral healthcare setting

ORAL HEALTH AND TYPE 2 DIABETES INFORMATION

Type 2 diabetes is the most common form of diabetes, occurring in more than 85% of people with diabetes.

Early diagnosis and treatment of this disease is critical to improving health outcomes.

What is iDENTify?

The Melbourne Dental School (MDS) at The University of Melbourne is conducting an important study to investigate screening people for type 2 diabetes and prediabetes in a private oral healthcare setting.

iDENTify aims to investigate if screening for type 2 diabetes and prediabetes in a private oral healthcare setting using the diabetes risk questionnaire (AUSDRISK) will help improve identification of asymptomatic people with undiagnosed type 2 diabetes or pre-diabetes.

Who is eligible to participate?

Dental patients need to meet all the following criteria to be eligible to participate;

- Over 35 years of age
- No existing type 2 diabetes or pre-diabetes diagnosis
- Not pregnant

What is involved?

- Complete a questionnaire to assess your risk of type 2 diabetes
- Participate in an oral health examination
- Follow-up with a general medical practitioner (GMP) if considered at risk of type 2 diabetes
- Participate in a completion interview

What are the benefits?

Participation will help improve identification of undiagnosed type 2 diabetes and pre-diabetes and will generate evidence to influence future policy and practice.
